We do use browser local storage to remember functional display preferences, such as your selected light or dark mode theme.

Our hosting and security provider, Cloudflare, may set strictly necessary cookies in certain situations, for example for security checks, bot protection, DDoS mitigation, or related network and performance features. These cookies are used to deliver and protect the website, not by us for advertising or behavioural tracking.
